

Minutes FARA May Committee meeting: 1930 Monday 24 May 2021

Meeting at Richborne Terrace

Agenda

1. Welcome to Val and apologies from Catriona. Present: Ros, Jill, Janice, Sally, Joanna, Val, Mike.
2. Minutes of the last meeting approved.
3. **Traffic**
 - a. **Sally** and **Janice** to follow up Flo Eshalomi's email by preparing for consultation. Discussion about atmosphere of intimidation from those opposed to LTN. Various tweaks suggested which **Sally** and **Janice** to take forward.
 - b. Agree to support request from Stephen Ludlow to the possible moving of the barriers further from the CR to provide business parking space (including a short free parking period) to help the businesses on the CR. **Jill** would prefer to see more support to the businesses to encourage customers to come on foot, cycle or public transport
 - c. Play streets. Propose Sunday September 12th. Need a volunteer for Fentiman. Propose a triangle-wide celebration. **Sally** and **Janice** to liaise with other RAs to make it a celebration of the LTN
4. **Planning:**
 - a. Europcar: Plans are being revised.
 - b. 3 and 15C RT: Our objections were accepted by Lambeth but the planning inspector rejected them on 3 and 15C has now been appealed to the inspector
 - c. 5G mast: Application refused
 - d. FR basements: RA is generally against
 - e. 20 Clapham Road: RA to support businesses on CR while being respectful of IMPACT's objections
5. **Greening**
 - a. Decision on the distribution of the donation from Stephen Ludlow: agree to split the money between the two streets proportional to their relative lengths and to offer some money for missing tree poles and planter waterer.
 - b. Request that we have a parklet on RT inside the planters rejected.
 - c. EV charging demands on RT and parts of FR and connecting roads. Residents need to register interest. **Sally** to publicise in newsletter.
6. **Oval Parade** conversation with Stephen Ludlow and IMPACT including participation in the St Matthews music and art festival. No firm ideas offered.
7. **Safer Neighbourhoods** : **Jill** reiterated the lack of crime and other problems in our area. **Joanna** said there is a way to report graffiti on the Lambeth website, but doing so has no obvious result.

8. **AGM**

 - b. *Speakers: Councillors?*
 - c. Getting more committee members particularly at the SLR end of FR. **Sally and Jill to investigate.**
